

Cookie Booth Etiquette



What is a cookie booth?

 A cookie booth is coordinated by the Council or Service Unit for Girl Scouts to sell cookies directly to customers who were not solicited during door-to-door sales



What is at a booth?

- Girls smiling and making eye contact with customers
- Posters showing the troop's Girl Scout Cookie goal
- Sign depicting the price of Girl Scout Cookies
- A clean neat display of all available cookie varieties
- No more than four girls at one time
- Two adults



Do

- Remember that I am a representative of Girl Scouts and that my behavior at Cookie Booths reflects on all of Girl Scouting
- Be polite and friendly
- Keep table and area neat
- Stay out of doorways and walkways
- Know what my troop will do with troop proceeds
- Be identifiable as a Girl Scout
- Dress appropriately for the weather
- Respect each retailer's policy regarding Cookie Booth procedures

Don't

- Get in the way of business customers
- Ask a customer more than once to purchase Girl Scout Cookies
- Go into the place of business while at a Cookie Booth
- Talk loudly or run around
- Chew gum or eat while at a Cookie Booth
- Leave trash behind
- Approach a parked car
