SWIM PROGRAM AT CAMP MARY ELIZABETH

Camp Mary Elizabeth has offered quality swim programs for over 20 years. American Red Cross-certified Water Safety Instructors and Lifeguards supervise all water programs. The junior Olympic pool is open to the public. Girls and boys ages 4 and up, adults, families and groups may all participate in swimming lessons and open swim.

FEES AND SCHEDULING

Fees for swim lessons are \$25 per session for registered Girl Scouts and \$30 per session for non-Girl Scouts. Please note that participants without a past course card will be tested and classified by the swim instructors according to swimming ability.

Swimmers may get the most from their swim lessons by registering for two consecutive weeks of instruction. The length of swim lessons is based on age and endurance of participants and may last up to one hour concluding with a 15-minute recreational swim. Lessons are held at 9:30 AM or 4:45 PM during each session. Girls who are participating in day camp and want to take swim lessons should register for the 4:45 swim lesson time.

SWIM SKILL LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Beginner: Introduction to Water Lessons include the following skill sets: water entry, breath control and underwater swimming, buoyancy on front and back, and treading water.

Intermediate: Fundamentals Swimmer should be able to swim on front and back. Lessons will focus on swim stroke development.

Advanced: Stroke Improvement Lessons will work on swim stroke improvement. Swimmer should perform an adequate swim stroke and be able to swim in deep water.

OPEN SWIM Open swim costs \$1.25 per person for one day. Please pay and obtain a receipt at the Camp Mary Elizabeth office in the Program Center.

Summer swimming passes (\$30 per person) and family passes (\$60 for two adults and up to five children) are valid June 6 – August 13, 2011. All children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult. You may purchase the summer swimming pass at the Spartanburg Service Center before June 6, 2011 and at the Camp Mary Elizabeth Program Center after this date.
