

Thrifty

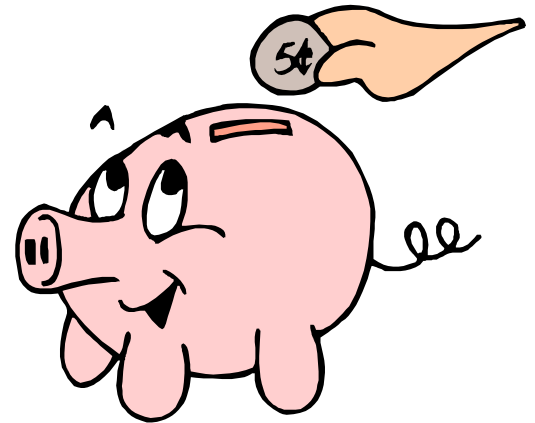
Do you practice economical management of your
