### Five Program Outcomes

**Girl Scouts** are more likely than non-Girl Scouts to:

- Develop a strong sense of self (**80%** vs. 68%)
- Display positive values (**75%** vs. 59%)
- Seek challenges and learn from setbacks (**62%** vs. 42%)
- Form and maintain healthy relationships (**60%** vs. 43%)
- Exhibit community problem-solving skills (**57%** vs. 28%)

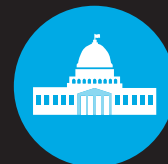
