





- Western Hemisphere Region (35 countries)





World Trefoil Pin



World Trefoil Pin - 1





- The World Trefoil Pin is the pin of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts. All members of WAGGGS wear this pin.
- The BLUE background stands for the sky which is over all Girl Guides and Girl Scouts.
- The GOLD stands for the sun which shines over all Girl Guides and Girl Scouts.
- The TREFOIL stands for the three parts of the Promise.


World Trefoil Pin - 2






- The BASE of the Trefoil is shaped like a flame and stands for the love of mankind and for the flame that burns in the hearts of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts around the World.
- The VEIN in the center of the Trefoil stands for the compass needle that points the way.
- The two STARS stand for the Promise and Law.
- The outer gold CIRCLE has a break in it which allows all countries to have an opportunity to join the movement.





World Conference




- A conference is held every three years by WAGGGS to make decisions about our world movement.
- There are two representatives sent from each of the 150 member countries.
- It is this body, the World Conference, that decided that we need a World Center in the Africa Region.
- Our GSUSA conventions also happen every three years.

Juliette Low World Friendship Fund



- The Juliette Low World Friendship Fund (JLWFF) was formed in 1927, to honor her commitment to world friendship.
- The Fund supports international friendship through service projects, training events, and exchange visits between Girl Guides and Girl Scouts across 150 nations, including GSUSA.
- The JLWFF makes possible an annual contribution from GSUSA to the World Thinking Day Fund.
- Contributions to the Fund are made voluntarily by girls and adults.

World Thinking Day Fund



A tradition since 1932, girls in member countries donate pennies and coins that they have collected to the Fund, to support their fellow Girl Guides and Girl Scouts around the world.

All donations help fund WAGGGS activities and are used where the need is greatest in our global Movement.

Global Action Award



In 2015, at the United Nations Summit, world leaders agreed to work together to accomplish the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (**SDGs**) by 2030.

They focus on topics like taking care of the environment, making sure all people have enough to eat, and improving people's health.

Although they're big goals, Girl Scouts know a thing or two about changing the world!

- Why was this date chosen? It is the birthdays of both the Founder Lord Baden-Powell and his wife, World Chief Guide, Olave Baden-Powell.
- It is celebrated by Girl Guides and Girl Scouts all over the world.














- Step 1: Take your empty egg carton and cut the top off.
